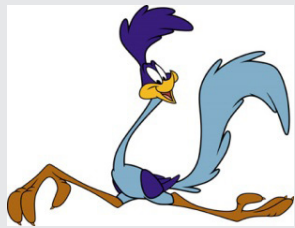
What is your Spiritual Charism?
