



## PASTOR'S COLUMN

### Leadership adjustments

Last weekend, I announced the hiring of our new Youth and Evangelization Coordinator, Chris Hiles. We thank the Catholic Foundation and several generous donor families for their support of this initiative. This week I wanted to mention a couple of other changes.

The first is I've asked Diane Corcoran to expand her involvement from the choir, to all three Masses, for the music. She has done a wonderful job with the choir and I thought it would be good to have her be over the music of all three Masses, just to help ensure continuity and consistency across all three Masses. She will help recruit cantors and work with them and will continue her work with the schola and choir. We are blessed with very good cantors and organist at St. Peter, but we are still in need of a few more cantors to help. See Diane if you are willing to share your gift in this area!

Also, in the area of Faith Formation, I have asked Tess Hatmacher to expand her role as PSR coordinator and also take over the First Confession and First Communion preparation. This will also free up some time for Judy Harness, Family Life Coordinator, to focus on the areas of marriage and family, with her intention of starting monthly evenings for marriage enrichment and a Families in Crisis Support, along with other initiatives.

### College Missionaries

One of the most important areas for missionaries today is our college campuses. Whether secular or Catholic, our college campuses are often the place where young adults fall away from the faith or become strong disciples after Jesus Christ. The presence of missionaries like FOCUS (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) or SPO (St. Paul's Outreach) often are a deciding factor in the lives of our college students as to which of those paths they go. This weekend, I have asked Daniella Straathof, a FOCUS missionary and parishioner of St. Colman, Washington Court House, to speak for a few minutes at the end of each Mass. Daniella is preparing to serve as a FOCUS missionary at Ave Maria in Florida this coming year. Daniella is asking for missionary partners to help support her. She will tell you about how you can become a monthly missionary partner. FOCUS missionaries must raise the funds to support themselves for the year. I have been a missionary partner for a FOCUS missionary for the past five or six years. It is rewarding to receive periodic updates about what the missionary is doing and how the Lord is working. I invite you to consider if the Lord is asking you to partner with a campus missionary in this way.

### Visitor from India

This week, Mother Rexia, the Superior General for the Franciscans of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, will be in town from India, visiting the convent and marking the two-year anniversary of the sisters' presence in our community. We look forward to her visit and we are grateful to God for the gift of the sisters and their mission here.

*\*Note Regarding Budgeted Offertory Amount: This is the corrected budget number for weekly expenses. This represents a modest \$275.00/week increase from last year. This number includes an increase of depreciation expense of \$17,000.00 to begin saving in relation to the parish center improvements. It also represents a return of the cost of parish center utilities to our budget – formerly due to the rental nature of the parish center the utilities were paid directly from the rental account (this includes the revenues from our rental properties that border the church property). These utilities now show up in our expenses as does the rental income now show up in our income. This increases the budgeted expenses. A reminder that what the bulletin compares is budgeted expenses to actual offertory. The church also receives some revenue through the rental income and gifts, etc. However, it is our goal for a healthy parish life, to pay all expenses from offertory – which is what will always be compared in this stewardship box of the bulletin.*
