



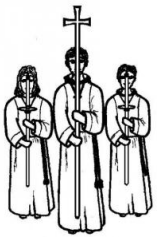
### **FAREWELL TO SR. SHANI MARY**

**Looking for the best preschool program around? Look no further than your parish school, Bishop Flaget!** Our preschool is licensed by the Ohio Department of Education and follows the school criteria set forth by the Ohio Catholic Schools Accrediting Association. We also have scholarships available for 4-year-old students whose family incomes fall below 200% of the poverty level (\$48,600 for a family of four). We currently have programs for three- and four-year-old students as well as early fives. The **EdChoice Expansion Program** has reopened the application window for students to apply for scholarships for the 2016-2017 school year. These scholarships are open to students in grades kindergarten through the third grade and will pay full tuition for students to attend Bishop Flaget. To be eligible, family incomes must be below 200% of the poverty level:
