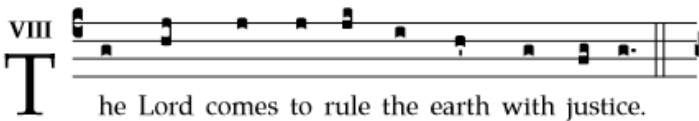
Altar flowers have been donated by the St. Peter Military Ministry in honor of all Veterans and Active Military Personnel.

In order to volunteer, you must have completed a background check and taken the Protecting God's Children class at some point.

Cards have been placed in the pews, with the words to the Kyrie (Lord Have Mercy), *Sanctus* (Holy, Holy, Holy) and *Agnus Dei* (Lamb of God), in both English and Latin. These responses, along with the *Credo* (Creed), are the **Ordinaries** of the Mass, that is, they stay the same each week. *The Lord's Prayer* in English and its Latin translation are also included on these cards. The **Propers** of the Mass are the liturgical texts that change, and are specific to each day. These include *the Introit* (or Entrance Antiphon), *Responsorial Psalm*, *the Offertory Chant*, and *the Communion Antiphon*. The words to *the Introit, Responsorial Psalm, and the Communion Antiphon* can be found in the Missalette.
