

These include the Kyrie (Lord Have Mercy), Gloria, Creed, Sanctus (Holy, Holy, Holy), and Agnus Dei (Lamb of God). During the four weeks of Advent, we will be singing the Nicene Creed at the 11:30 a.m. Mass. It can be found in the Saint Michael Hymnal #126. Cards have been placed in the pews with the words to the Kyrie (Lord Have Mercy), Sanctus (Holy, Holy, Holy) and Agnus Dei (Lamb of God) in both English and Latin.
