### ***Theology of Dance***

After witnessing firsthand the degrading behavior of “grind dancing” at their son’s high school prom, Mark and Elizabeth Ficocelli began a ministry of teaching swing dance to high school and college youth, incorporating into it the message of respectful intimacy. This has evolved into a full-length presentation given at youth gatherings that draws a striking correlation between ballroom dance and healthy male/female relationships. The talk discusses the importance of good communication, how to be a lead worth following, what it means to follow, the need for trust, and respectful touch and intimacy. Afterwards, the Ficocellis lead audiences of all ages in a fun swing dance lesson to make these concepts come alive!



Elizabeth Ficocelli is a Catholic author of fifteen books for adults and young people, a popular speaker at conferences, parishes, schools and events, a frequent guest on Catholic radio and television, and the host of “Answering The Call” on St. Gabriel Catholic Radio AM 820. Mark Ficocelli is a core team leader for the “That Man Is You” men’s ministry program at St. Pius X, a Third Degree Knight of Columbus in the Fr. Hohman Council 5253, a Boy Scout Leader for over 15 years, and a member of the praise band, “Merging

Spirits,” at St. Pius X. Elizabeth and Mark have been married 32 years and have four sons, ages 17 to 27. They reside in Reynoldsburg, Ohio.
