Happy Easter and Thank You to all who worked so hard to make Holy Week a beautiful time of accompanying our Lord through His Passion and to His Resurrection. Many people did a lot of hard work and it honored our Lord and helped us all to experience the graces of the Triduum.

We are now in the octave of Easter, which concludes with the Second Sunday of Easter, better known as Divine Mercy Sunday. I will be on pilgrimage from April 11-26. You will all certainly be in my prayers and I ask for yours.
