Happy Feast of Divine Mercy!

This is one of the newer devotions in the Church, as well as one of the most popular. In 2000, Pope John Paul II declared the 2nd Sunday after Easter as, Divine Mercy Sunday. St. Faustina is the saint to whom this devotion was revealed. The Lord told her, "now is the time of mercy, after it will come the day of justice." We are accordingly encouraged to go to His Mercy now rather than meet His justice later. We are encouraged to adore Him in the Eucharist and venerate the Image of Divine Mercy, to be reconciled to Him through regular use of the Sacrament of Confession, and to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. This takes on added significance in this the "Year of Mercy."

Here at St. Peter we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, beginning after the 11:30 a.m. Mass and concluding after the praying and singing of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at 3:00 p.m. Please stop in and pray awhile and seek the great graces that God pours out around this special Feast.

Also, remember that our Year of Mercy Parish Mission is coming up. Fr. Thomas Blau, O.P., will be preaching the Masses of April 16-17 and then will give the mission each evening, Sunday-Tuesday at 7:00 p.m.

Also, a reminder that I will be leaving for my backpacking Holy Land pilgrimage next Monday, April 11, please let me know of any intentions you would like me to carry.
