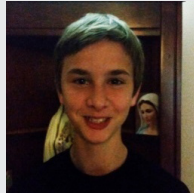


HELP THE TEENS GET TO MEXICO

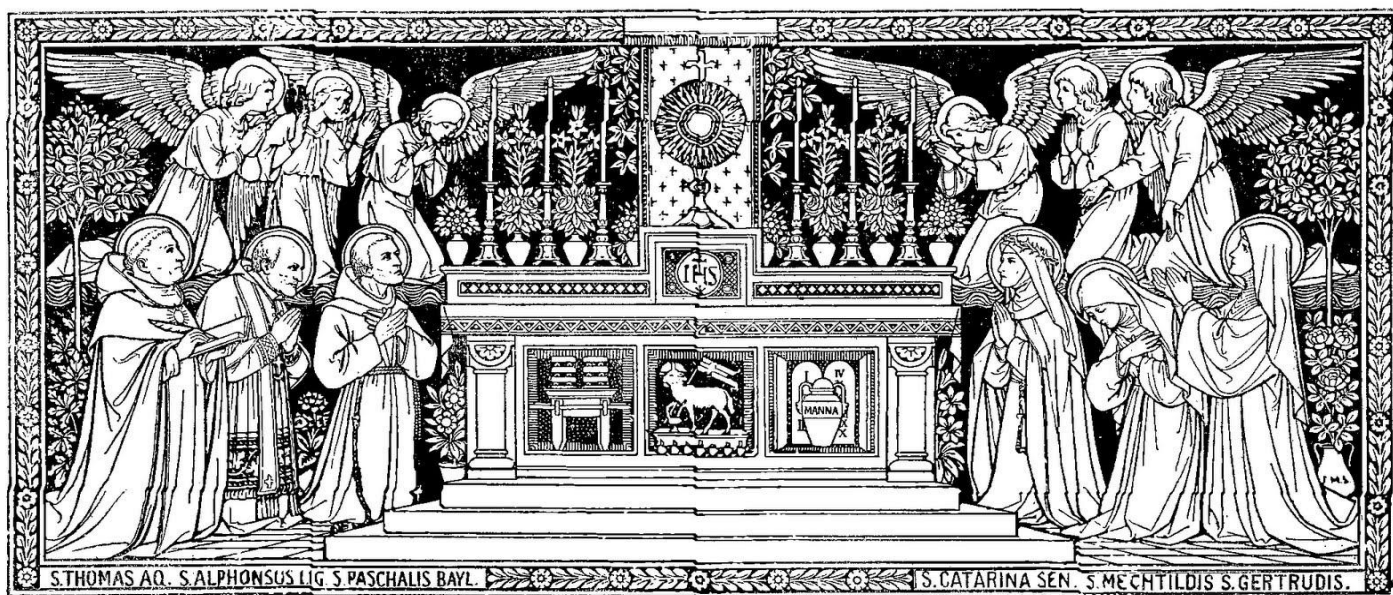

The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ is a celebration of the great gift that Jesus has given us in the Eucharist—His own Body and Blood. This feast day was begun in 1264 by Pope Urban IV, at the request of St. Juliana of Mont Cornillon. The tradition of having a procession with the Eucharist was developed about the same time. Our participation in this great tradition will be an opportunity to worship our Lord in the Eucharist and to proclaim to the local community our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus' Body and Blood in the Eucharist. While processing around our neighborhood, we will sing hymns, say prayers, and pause to receive Benediction from Jesus Himself, who is truly present in the Holy Eucharist.

The procession will begin immediately following the 11:30 Mass. For those attending a different Mass, please meet us outside the front doors of St. Peter's Church at about 12:30 to join the procession. This is an event for the whole family from young children to adults. The route this year will be around our neighborhood, and will end at the Church with a feast including hotdogs and shaved ice.

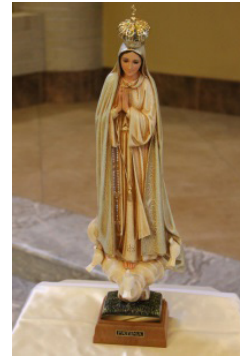
