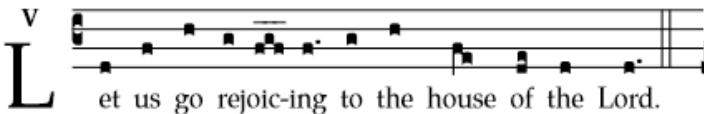

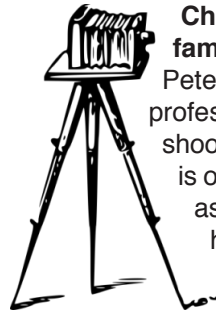

In order to volunteer, you must have completed a background check and taken the Protecting God's Children Class at some point.

Cards have been placed in the pews with the words to the Kyrie (*Lord Have Mercy*), Sanctus (*Holy, Holy, Holy*) and Agnus Dei (*Lamb of God*) in both English and Latin. These responses, along with the Credo (*Creed*) are the **Ordinaries** of the Mass, that is they stay the same each week. The Lord's Prayer in English and its Latin translation are also included on these cards. The **Propers** of the Mass are the liturgical texts that change, and are specific to each day. These include the *Introit (or Entrance Antiphon)*, *Responsorial Psalm*, the *Offertory Chant*, and the *Communion Antiphon*. The words to the *Introit*, *Responsorial Psalm*, and the *Communion Antiphon* can be found in the *Missalette*.

The Choir is starting to work on music for Christmas. If you would like to sing for the Midnight Mass, please come to practices on Wednesdays, at 7:30 p.m., in the Choir Loft. Hope you can join us! For more information, call Diane Corcoran at 740-703-2196.
