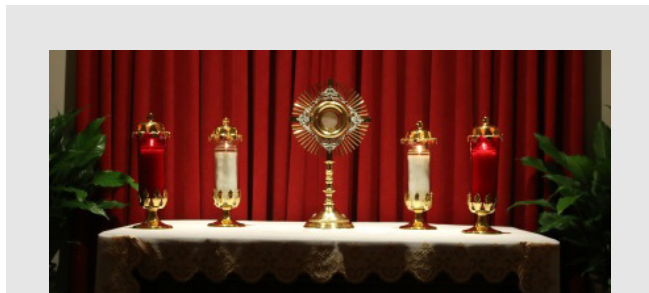


**Infant of Prague Perpetual Adoration Chapel:**
