The Scioto Society partners each month with a food bank in Pickaway, Pike or Ross County to help stock their pantry shelves. Our St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry has been chosen as the partner for July. Each Monday night, Ohio residents will be invited to save \$10 on their regular adult tickets when they provide proof of residence and AT LEAST two cans of food per person. Tickets will be available beginning at 2PM on the day of the show, limited to one per person, and are not available over the phone or online. Our Vincentians will be on site each Monday evening (July only) to gather and sort the donations and provide information about our mission to serve those in need in our community. You will enjoy the spectacular outdoor drama, with a significantly discounted ticket. Our pantry might gain 600 to 1,300 cans of food each Monday night. We are grateful for this generous opportunity. And we look forward to seeing you!

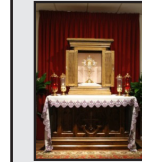
