Do you have a garden? With the onset of summer, everyone's gardens start to produce. If you have a garden and have a bountiful harvest, the St. Vincent de Paul food pantry welcomes any extra fresh fruits and vegetables to pass along to those they serve. The pantry is open Tuesday mornings and Friday afternoons. Items can be dropped off at the parish office or to the pantry directly on the days they are open.

Do you donate clothes to Goodwill? At St. Vincent de Paul, we sometimes have clients who need new clothes, and we are able to give them vouchers to buy them at Goodwill. If you or anyone you know donates a large bag of clothing to Goodwill, and fills out the donation form with our name on it (St. Peters St. Vincent de Paul), we will get a credit toward the vouchers that we give out. Your donation to Goodwill helps that organization, and in this way it will also help our own St. Vincent de Paul. Thank you for considering this.

Are you planning to join us here at St. Peter's for Latin Mass on Tuesday, August 1st? At 7:00 p.m., Fr. Ty Tomson will celebrate the Feast of St. Peter in Chains with Mass in the Extraordinary Form. Pope Pius XI stated that; "The Church – precisely because it embraces all nations and is destined to endure until the end of time – of its very nature requires a language which is universal, immutable, and non-vernacular." (Officiorum Omnium) But there is more about the Latin Mass than just the language that is different from our Novus Ordo Masses. The Latin Mass has a more reverent tone that can help to make us more aware of the respect and adoration due to Our Lord in the Eucharist. So come and witness the liturgical richness of the past, in the Mass itself and in the music that will accompany it.
