Latin Mass at St. Peter will be celebrated this Tuesday, August 1, at 7:00 p.m. Will you join us, and Fr. Ty Tomson as celebrant for this special opportunity?

Why Latin Mass? Latin was used in the rites of the Western Church since at least the 4th century, if not earlier! There are many benefits of the Latin Rite, including those relating to sacred music. "The treasury of sacred music is to be preserved and fostered with great care," according to the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, 114. This summer, the choir has rehearsed music for this Mass, at the guidance of Fr. Tomson and Diane Corcoran. We have been eager to learn these traditional responses, etc. As you know, we have been incorporating chant and some Latin Hymns into Sunday Masses, and this has been a joyful and enlightening experience for us. Some of the responses may bring back memories for some, and inspire an interest in learning about this ancient form of worship for others. Also, we will try to have some chapel veils available for ladies who wish to wear one.



The Feast of Assumption is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses at St. Peter will be Monday, August 14 at 7:00 p.m. and Tuesday, August 15 at 8:30 a.m. Sign-up sheets for Liturgical Ministers can be found on the table in the back of church.

School is right around the corner ... If your child is not attending Bishop Flaget, they are required to attend the Parish School of Religion. Registration for 2017-2018 PSR (1-8) will be after all the Masses, August 26/27 and September 2/3, in the Parish Center. Also, note that Preschool/Kindergarten PSR (aged 3-K) will be offered this year and registration will be required and be on the above dates. PSR will begin Sunday, September 10, 9:15-11:00 a.m., with Pre/K Class beginning September 17. The Pre/K class will be in the Holy Innocents room across from the St. Vincent de Paul room in the basement of the parish center.
