The two disciples in Luke's Gospel did the same exact thing. Their terror almost prevented them from seeing the Risen Lord. Our fears and uncertainties can cause us to miss the divine right in front of us. May you have the courage and peace to give all to our loving God.

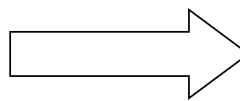
The translation is:

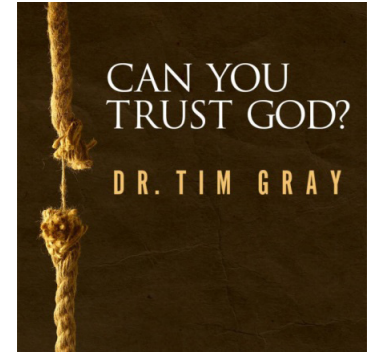
